Report by Town Chairman

- 2024 Recap

Wenzel reported road work completed was reconstruction on Hwy XX for \$180,430.00, reconstruction on Trudgion Rd west for \$75,400.00, crack fill & chip sealing on Elinor Dr for \$28,890.00 & crack fill & chip sealing on Trellis Rd for \$4,200.00.

- 5 Year Plan

➤ Wenzel reported redoing McMahon Rd which is a TRID project 50/50 split with the State;

- Start road work on Creek Rd at Sweetheart City Rd going east as far as money allows;
- Pothole filling started today at Creek Rd & will go through the entire town to fill potholes so, if anyone sees potholes along the roads please call myself or the office to let us know where;
- Going to be seeking bids for snow plowing & brushing of roads for this upcoming season... details to follow;
- The annual road inspection w/Pat Schlies will be on April 22, 2025 at 1:00pm;
- We would like to in the future have a back up generator installed at the Town Hall for use in the event of an emergency &/or disaster;
- I have been actively seeking rough bids to get the Town Hall remodeled so we can apply for a grant & have not been having much luck so far;
- I would personally like to Thank our 2 clerks for the wonderful work they have been doing for the Town... There probably isn't any 2 supervisors that have went out of their way to save the Town money like these 2 we have now.

Elector Comments

- Mark Dobbson: Asked what is going on with the FD regarding the agreement between Crivitz FD & MIFD? Wenzel gave some explanation on MABAS & AutoAid. Chief Kleuskens explained how AutoAid works & some discussions on FD billing for calls.
- Mac Rhode: It sounds like CFD would pay for MIFD would resolve the matter. Assistant Chief Wenzel replied to Rhode & explained
- Jeff Bonikowski: Gave data on CFD costs to come to help MIFD & how the 2 departments fulfill State statues.
- Steve Marvin: Is on the MIFD & gave data along with statues requirements... If the requirements are not met MIFD could lose their 2% dues that are about \$6,000.00.
- April Pomeroy: Agrees with AutoAid
- Mandy Rhode: Appreciates this community, agrees with AutoAid & thinks the Board & MIFD should communicate more with each other & have more transparency.
- Roger Leick: Stated there will be a bigger problem if the Board & MIFD can't get along & dissension grows.
- John Guarisco: Agrees with AutoAid
- Mark VanDerZee: Gave explanation of how hard it is to get members & with the AutoAid this lends to both departments having what they need to get the job done.
- Darleen Haas: Had used the FD a few times & agrees with AutoAid.
- Jeff Bonikowski: Asked if the Wed. Recycling hours could be moved to evening hours 4p-6p?

- Maria Knepel: Makes a motion to have a binding referendum to increase the current 3 member Board to a 5 member Board under advisory; Knepel/Edge (57/0); Carried.
- Wenzel said the Raven Rd signs will be installed regarding ATV/UTV.
- Sally Linsink: Asked when the potholes are going to get fixed on Raven Rd? Wenzel said the portion will get graveled.
- Edge: Boat Landing & Elinor Dr potholes.
- Carol Bausch: Maple Beach potholes.
- Darleen Haas: When is Rector Rd getting paved? Wenzel said eventually.
- CT Schutte said the NEW Town phone number is 920-514-1033 effective May 1, 2025
- Pomeroy stated to let the Board members know if there's any problem with Spectrum burying lines.
- Resident in Sweetheart City would like culvert to put back in on North St...when road work was being done the culvert was removed & never put back in.
- Chief Kleuskens: Thanked everyone for coming to the meeting.


